PALM SUNDAY



On the Christian calendar, Palm Sunday is the Sunday before Easter. The name comes from the triumphal entry of Jesus into the holy city of Jerusalem and how the people waved branches taken from the palm trees to celebrate Jesus' arrival. Palm Sunday is often marked in churches with songs of praise and the joyful shouts of God's children.

We invite you to join us **this Sunday, April 10 at 9 or 11 am** to add your voice to the chorus of praise.

MAUNDY THURSDAY



You are invited to join the church family **Thursday, April 14** for supper and our Maundy Thursday Communion Service. A fellowship meal will be served starting at **5:30 pm** in McLeod Hall. At **6:30 pm**, we will gather on this holy night in the sanctuary for a worship service and the Lord's Supper. The evening will conclude with the Tenebrae (Service of Darkness) as we listen to readings from the last hours of Jesus' life, extinguishing candles and stripping the church, until we leave the darkened worship space.

The service will be live streamed and individual communion elements are available in the church office. We invite you to prepare for Good Friday and Easter at this special service.
