They are in particular need of deodorant, disposable razors, small combs, quart and snack size zip lock bags, Band-Aids, washcloths, sunscreen, small hand sanitizer, and small samples from hotel/motels. Also, any and all items for the senior bags, whatever will make their senior citizens' lives easier and brighter: laundry soap, Lysol cleaning wipes, paper towels, mugs or plastic plates, bowls, teabags, oatmeal packs, crossword puzzles/activity pads, seasonal item/décor, gift cards (Walmart, restaurants, etc.) You can put these items in the Angels Care collection box located in McLeod Hall.

OUR STEPHEN MINISTER TRAINING CLASS HAS BEGUN

We ask you to keep our Stephen Minister trainees in your prayers as they nurture their gifts and acquire new skills so that they can bring Christ's love and care to hurting people on behalf of our congregation. Also pray for our Stephen Leaders who will guide them through their training.



In **Session One,** *The Person of the Caregiver*, our Stephen Minister trainees received an introduction to the 50 hours of training and explored the Christ-centered foundation of Stephen Ministry.

And in **Session Two**, the trainees learned that *Feelings: Your, Mine, and Ours Feelings,* are a gift from God. In this session our Stephen Minister trainees learned to help people recognize, accept, and express their feelings, and invite them to trust God to bring them healing and wholeness. They explored the benefits of expressing feelings and the harm that can come when feelings remain unexpressed.


