

## **OUR STEPHEN MINISTER TRAINING CLASS**

Our Stephen Ministers are learning about listening this week. Please continue to pray for them as they grow in their ability to provide caring ministry on behalf of our congregation.



In **Session Three**, *The Art of Listening*, our Stephen Minister trainees learned that listening is an essential part of Stephen Ministry. Stephen Ministers use active listening skills to help people recognize and accept the feelings they are experiencing. In this session Stephen Ministers learn and practice the skill of reflecting as a valuable listening tool. They explore the many facets of listening and talk about their own experiences so as to better understand when listening is effective and when it feels fake or makes a person feel uncomfortable.

In **Session Four,** *Distinctively Christian Caring*, Ministers will explore the essentials of using their Christian faith in caring for another, drawing on the resources of prayer, witnessing, the Bible, forgiveness, blessings, and more. An important motto of Stephen Ministry is "The Stephen Minister is the caregiver, and God is the curegiver." This training session underscores this Christ-centered focus for Stephen Ministers


