The women of our congregation have now completed another 500 dresses that we will deliver to little girls in the villages we visit!

The students at Brigham Academy held a pencil drive and have donated our 4000 pencils that our team will share with the students in the schools near the churches of the Presbytery of Honduras!

Folks in our church have donated clothes for little boys that we will share as we minister in various locations!

From the generosity of people over the past two years we have nearly 1000 stuffed animals that we will be distributing in the hospitals and villages during our trip!
