





SECUREGIVE NEWS

With each transaction, there are fees charged by the credit card processing companies. Securegive now has a "Separate Fee Offset" option when giving online. This option, if chosen, will increase the transaction to help offset transaction fees, the fee amount will be calculated based on the selected payment method. These fees are up to 2.5% of the transaction depending on the card used (the amount will be shown once the option is chosen).

New donors will see this as one of their options and they must select yes or no. If you are currently using the online service you will need to go into your account and update your information, as it is not automatic.

OUR STEPHEN MINISTER TRAINING CLASS

Please continue to lift up our Stephen Ministers, leaders, and trainees in prayer. Here is what our trainees are currently studying.



Session Seven and Eight (March 13), Assertiveness: Relating Gently and Firmly. Assertiveness has gained a bad name for itself in some circles of the church. It has been taken to mean "getting my own way," which is erroneous. In fact, assertiveness is about relating to others gently and firmly. Stephen Ministers discuss and apply the principles they read about in the book Speaking the Truth in Love: How to Be an Assertive Christian, which uses Jesus as the model for assertive behavior. Our Stephen Ministers explore the topic of assertiveness, using Jesus as the model for assertive behavior. They take a look at the differences between passive, aggressive, and assertive behavior.

Session Nine (March 16), Maintaining Boundaries in Caregiving. Our Stephen Ministers are learning the importance of establishing boundaries both to protect themselves from manipulation and also to guard against their own controlling impulses. In Crisis Theory and Practice: Danger versus Opportunity, our Stephen Ministers are also learning the effects of crises on people's faith. They are exploring how to help a person experiencing a crisis to move toward greater wholeness.

WORSHIP MASK POLICY

Everyone is required to wear a face covering and maintain social distancing while entering, moving throughout, and exiting the building.

People who wish to attend in-person worship at 9 am are asked to:

Once seated and socially distanced from all people except those in their chosen seating group, they may remove their face mask, if they choose, for that portion of the worship service.

If any person wishes to sing hymns or responses, we ask that the face covering is replaced.

And people who wish to attend in-person worship at 11 am will be asked to follow our current worship guideline which includes:

Face coverings are required to be worn at all times while seated for worship.

Worshipers are invited to sing while wearing face coverings.

Our session continues to review COVID safety measures for worship monthly.
