

The Flamingos Are Returning To First Pres!

It's that time of year again when flocks of flamingos begin mysteriously arriving in the yards of unsuspecting church members. PERSPECTIVES SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY HAS BEGUN

This class is studying *Man's Search For Meaning*, a book by Dr. Viktor Frankl to guide discussion. Dr. Frankl and his family were sent to a Nazi concentration camp in 1942. There he would experience the death of his pregnant wife, both parents and brother. From that experience, he, as a psychiatrist, focused on human suffering. He reminds us that while we cannot avoid suffering, we can choose how to cope with suffering and even find meaning in the midst of our suffering, while we move forward with renewed purpose.
