


PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN BIBLE STUDY

Outstanding Older Adults 2020

Born in Old Towne, Maine as one of three girls raised by a devout Baptist mother – this honoree was never far from church as a child, and she stayed very close to the church as an adult (and preacher's wife.) She met her husband, Ray, when he was a seminary intern pastor and she was an executive assistant for the director of the Bangor Eastern Medical Center. They married in less than a year, and over 50 years and 5 children later they are still enjoying life as husband and wife. She was a partner in raising her 5 kids (Lynn, Susan, Kenny, Laura, and Tim), and worked outside the manse for the Cincinnati Board of Education, in the office at Watson and Watson, and then in the City Clerk's Office, from which she retired here in Winter Haven.



This honoree is an amazing seamstress (Halloween costumes, wedding gowns and bridesmaid dresses, and a baptismal gown that has become a treasured family heirloom), a phenomenal cook, and hostess. She has served on our Fellowship and Hospitality Committee, logging countless hours in the church kitchen, the Session, Stephen Ministry, and she is a faithful member of our church's Monday Morning Counting Crew.

We are pleased to honor GLADYS LARSON as one of our 2020 Outstanding Older Adults.





Our second honoree was born in Ocala, Florida, and moved to Winter Haven when she was 4 years old. She graduated from Winter Haven High School and went to work for GTE. She married her husband Ralph in 1957, one year after high school. They raised three wonderful children, Steve, Mike, and Diane. She was a charter member of the St. John's United Methodist Church where she taught Sunday School, directed VBS, and was active in circles and prayer groups. She returned to school and received her degree in nursing from PCC in 1977, and then went to work at Winter Haven Hospital, for 25 years, ending her career in the Surgical Intensive Care Unit. She then also worked for a time at Good Shepherd Hospice. Ralph died in 2011, and our honoree started attending First Pres.

She stays very involved in the lives of her 3 children, 10 grandchildren, and 4 great-grandchildren. She cooks, gardens, travels, and loves time with friends and family. An ordained Deacon, she also gives time to our Living Nativity, VBS, Membership and Congregational Care Committees, Sanctuary Committee, Nominating Committee, and she watches the phones every Tuesday morning so that the church staff all meet together (and she often brings the staff home-baked goodies!).
