

OUR NEXT FUNTIMERS IS WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18

We are going to the Mulberry Phosphate Museum in Mulberry and the bus leaves 9:45 am.

We will have a docent led tour of the box car galleries that compose the museum. The Phosphate Gallery, located in the first set of box cars, shows how phosphate is found, how it is mined and processed, and how we use it in our everyday life. The second set of cars houses historic photos and info on Polk County, the railroad industry and the phosphate industry. The Fossil Gallery is located in the historic train depot. The outdoor exhibit features a 44 yard Dragline bucket once used to dig phosphate out of the ground. Museums visitors can try their luck at finding shark teeth and other prehistoric animal remains.

AVAILABLE FOR LOAN








EMBRACING: FORGIVENESS WITH BARBARA CAWTHORNE CRAFTON – ROOM 207



Join Bill Lockhart and videos with Barbara Cawthorne Crafton as we study embracing forgiveness – beginning with clarity that eases the guilt often associated with the lack of forgiveness by saying what it isn't. It is not a job or task; it is not a conditional act to earn God's love. It is, Crafton believes, a spiritual gift given freely by a God who simply wants to connect with us. Over the five-week study, she shows how forgiveness can remove the tumor of anger from our hearts to become a means of grace that gives back our humanity.
