


THE CHOSEN

Fanny was a 19th-century American hymn writer, poet, musician, and missionary. She penned more than 8,000 hymn texts and gospel songs; some of which include: *To God Be the Glory, Blessed Assurance,* and *Rescue the Perishing*. Blinded by a physician when she was just a baby, Fanny did not let her blindness hinder her music or her incredible faith.
