The Joy Circle meets on the **3rd Tuesday** of each month, the next meeting is **November 19** at **10:00** am at Carol Carter's house.


The Lydia Circle meets on the **3rd Thursday** of each month, the next meeting is **November 21 at 10:00 am** in the Manor Conference Room in the church office.
