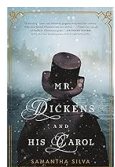

A light reception will follow in McLeod Hall. There is no cost to attend the concert, however, a free-will offering will be accepted at the door. Hope to see you there!

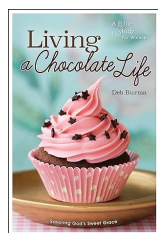
NOVEMBER BOOK CLUB
