


#### BRING YOUR CHILD FOR ACOLYTE TRAINING


#### JOIN ONE OF OUR MUSICAL ENSEMBLES, OR TWO!

# Rehearsals begin September 3.

Beginning September 3<sup>rd</sup>, the new musical season begins with all of our ensembles. You are invited to participate! Singing in the Chancel choir is a great way to have a close fellowship with a group, and a way to reduce stress, learn about music, and enrich your life. They are open to all high schoolers and adults and they rehearse Wednesday night's from 7:00-8:30. Child care is provided as needed, just give at least 24 hours notice.






#### THIS SUNDAY, AUGUST 31, IS THE LAST SUNDAY FOR OUR SUMMER SCHEDULE

This summer, First Presbyterian Church has offered two varied opportunities for worship. Both Sunday morning worship services helped us focus on God through the same scripture and sermon and both include a Time for Younger Disciples.

At 8:30 a.m., members and friends of First Presbyterian Church are invited to attend The Gathering. This service is held in the sanctuary. The piano is the primary instrument for leading in congregational music with a variety of instruments adding special touches from week to week. The prayers in worship and the flow of the service helps the congregation gather in God's love. The Gathering ordinarily lasts 50 minutes and will conclude with the Benediction at 9:20 a.m.

At 10:30 a.m. you are invited to attend our later morning worship. This service is held in the sanctuary with music and responses regularly led by our chancel choir and accompanied by organ and piano. In the tradition of our church cultivated over the last few decades, a full liturgy gives the congregation opportunities for spiritual enrichment and the sense of God's love and grace. This worship service ordinarily lasts one hour and concludes with the Benediction at 11:30 a.m.
