
CIRCLE MEETINGS


11:00 a.m. ~ Sanctuary Worship

We gave out 1,065 bag lunches in April, 2017.


Soup Kitchen Ministry

We fed 60 people on 4/29/17.


We fed 401 people in April, 2017.

OUR NEXT ODD MONTH, ODD MONDAY BOOK DISCUSSION IS ALMOST HERE




