Even if our world is no longer surrounded by kingly rulers, these Psalms can be particularly helpful because they can provide divine comfort in God's order. Prophetic psalms offer a glimpse into the future and through the poetic words we begin to see the future of Christ's coming. As we journey toward the cross at Easter, and our king of kings, these two types of Psalms through comfort and prophecy point us toward Jesus and help prepare our hearts for the coming days.

MEN'S FELLOWSHIP LUNCH EACH TUESDAY


